Background of the students

Among the same 20-30 students making up the delegation, it was a pleasant surprise to realize that there were in fact four of them coming from Hong Kong to continue their further study in the mainland. Therefore, some of them actually returned to their “home”!

Activities of the delegation in our firm

The delegation received a warm welcome from our staff. Then they attended a briefing session offered by our managing partner, Mr. Junius Ho on “how Hong Kong lawyers carry out their practices under the “One Country, Two Systems” Regime and we also focused on the salient features of the Basic Law of Hong Kong. Thereafter, the delegation was guided through the procedures of how foreign lawyers to be qualified as Hong Kong lawyers – which are matters of concern to the delegation as some of the students planned to come to Hong Kong to work after obtaining their LLB degree from the Beijing University.

The briefing session was followed by a Q & A session where useful exchanges were conducted between the delegation and our presenters. Thereafter, the delegation toured around our firm to observe how a typical law firm operates.
